The Crofoot is centrally located in the heart of Oakland County, north of Detroit. The venue is 20 minutes from I-696, 5 minutes from I-75, 6 blocks from M-59, and one block from Woodward Ave. The Crofoot is fifteen minutes from both Great Lakes Crossing Mall and The Somerset Collection. Ten minutes away is Daimler Chrysler's American Headquarters, GM's Centerpoint Complex, and The Palace of Auburn Hills. The train station across the street operates Amtrak's Wolverine Line to Chicago. LakeShore Airlines offers non stop flights to and from Chicago with 5 minute check in. Oakland County Airport is 15 minutes from our front door. Flight time to Chicago is 1 hour, fares are reasonable. A variety of hotels are moments away and an abundance of parking sits just across the street.



The Crofoot is located on the South East corner of Pike and Saginaw Streets in the heart of downtown Pontiac. The venue is one block North of the Phoenix Amphitheater, 6 Blocks South of M-59 (Huron Street) and located in the center of the Wide Track Loop (Woodward Loop).



LOAD IN:

Crofoot Ballroom:

Park on Pike St close to the alley. Please leave blinkers on. If possible feel free to pull onto the sidewalk. Load in through 36" conventional doors directly into the ballroom.

Sometimes buses park out front and load in through the Crofoot Cafe (36" door) please discuss with PM or responsible talent buyer.



Pike Room at the Crofoot:

Park on Pike street with back of trailer / bus just east of the three red doors. Please leave blinkers on. If possible feel free to pull onto the sidewalk. Load in through 36" conventional doors into lobby, take elevator up to 2nd floor, Pike Room is upstairs to the left as you exit the elevator.

Some times buses park out front and load in through the Crofoot Cafe (36" door) please discuss with PM or responsible talent buyer.



Vernors Room at the Crofoot:

Park on Saginaw street directly in front of the Vernors Room. Please leave blinkers on. Load in through 36" conventional door diretly into the room.




Loaders:

If we're providing loaders, please advance requirements with pm@thecrofoot.com as early as possible. The Crofoot management must know *call-time* 72 hours prior to the show for proper scheduling. If you have any questions, please email pm@thecrofoot.com.

Parking:

Please discuss with us your parking needs. Street parking is available some nights of the week. Directly across the street from the venue is a huge, guarded, and lit lot. All vehicles must move to parking lot after loading is finished, they cannot live in the load-in zone.

Busses should park on the SOUTH side of the lot with the front of the bus facing EAST, nose up to the bike racks closing off the exit for the general public (see diagram). This ensures an easy exit when the parking lot is filled with patron vehicles. Crofoot staff will move bike racks for exiting at the end of the night.



Sound Check:

<u>Crofoot Ballroom</u>: Soundcheck by default is scheduled to start 4 hours before scheduled door time, unless it has been advanced otherwise. Please let us know what you'd like to do.

<u>Pike Room & Vernors Room</u>: Soundcheck by default is scheduled to start 3 hours before scheduled door time, unless it has been advanced otherwise. Please let us know what you'd like to do.

The headlining band will be given a sound check first, followed by the opening band. Others as time allows.

Merchandise:

If you are going to need a merchandise seller, please advance this with marketing@thecrofoot.com no less than 72 hours notice. The rate for sellers is \$60 payable directly to the merch seller.

All hospitality is subject to budget. However, we're here to make you happy, let us know how we can improve your visit.

We have toothbrushes, mouthwash, and bathing supplies in our office closet. Need something quick? Ask us, we may have it.

Drinks:

Unless advanced otherwise, two drinks will be provided per band member. Gratuity for the bartenders is not included so please don't forget to tip your bartender.

Free sodas and water are provided for all performers at the bar, coffee & teas are available in the green room.

Please do not bring outside alcohol into the venue, as it will put our license in jeopardy and we want to be able to host shows for many years to come.

Guest List Policy:

Please submit performer/crew list and guest list with full names to the door staff no later than one hour before doors.

Please make sure that guests that are allowed backstage access receive proper wristbands upon check-in, as guests may not be allowed backstage or in the basement without the proper colored wristband.

All guest list requests are subject to capacity.

- 1. Ad Agencies We work with several Ad Agencies in town. If you can get into town earlier in the day, we can help organize a short performance at an Agency. It doesn't pay typically, but its great exposure for licensing think Ford/GM/Chyrsler commercials.
- 2. UHF Records Royal Oak, MI. UHF is a thriving all vinyl record store. They have a stage and small PA in house. We can coordinate an in store performance or a meet and greet pre-show event.
- 3. Video Interviews The Crofoot has an in-house video team. We'd love to spend 30 minutes interviewing your band. We'll cut it together in a slick fashion, give you an oppourtunity to review it, and then release it via youtube when we all feel good about it.
- 4. Magnetic Recording Around the corner from the venue is a really special recording studio. Featuring a small live room, and several underground echo chambers. There is an apartment upstairs available for overnight stays. The facility is reasonable, and the owners are bad ass.
- 5. Sight-Seeing Viral Videos With our in-house video team in tow, we'll take you and your band to a relevent and approapriate local attraction or historic site. We''ll shoot a video of the whole thing, and we can both use it as a promotonal tool.
- 6. Crofoot Party Line while you're here, or a few days before the show, join us for a specially promoted Facebook chat with fans.
- 7. Looking for something fun to do? How about a guided tour of Detroit? For \$10 per person (minimum 4 people) our guide can take you on a specially design tour depening on your interests (musical sites, historic buildings, etc).




